

# HARRISON HIGH SCHOOL – CHEERLEADING BOOSTER CLUB

## CONSTITUTION

### ARTICLE I TITLE

The name of this Organization shall be the Harrison High School Cheerleading Booster Club (HHSCBC).

### ARTICLE II PURPOSE

The purpose of this Organization shall be to support cheerleading activities at Harrison High School in the following manner:

- A. Promote parent and student involvement
- B. Coordinate all supporting activities
- C. Encourage attendance at cheer-related functions
- D. Provide financial support for those services, facilities and equipment not provided for by the school
- E. Ensure recognition for the program and its cheerleaders

### ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be granted to any parent(s) of a cheerleader or mascot of Harrison High School, who has paid family dues and agrees to abide by the Constitution and By-Laws

The Principal/designee and all Coaches of the Harrison cheerleading program shall be non-paying and non-voting members of the HHSCBC.

### ARTICLE IV DUES

Amount and method of payment of dues shall be governed by the By-Laws.

### ARTICLE V EXECUTIVE BOARD

**SECTION ONE** The Organization shall be governed by the Executive Board, which shall be selected from the General Membership.

**SECTION TWO** The Executive Board shall be responsible for the general welfare of the Organization and the Organization's actions to the General Membership.

**SECTION THREE** The Executive Board shall be comprised of two (2) Co-Presidents; one (1) Vice-President for each cheerleading squad; a Secretary, a Treasurer; and all Harrison Cheerleading Coaches. The Principal/designee shall serve as an ex-officio member; however the Principal/designee may vote only in order to eliminate a tie.

No one person may serve in more than one office at any one time.

**SECTION FOUR** The Co-Presidents may create ad-hoc committees and appoint the chairpersons and members of said committees.

**SECTION FIVE** Vacancies in office shall be filled by appointment of the Co-Presidents with the approval of the Executive Board.

**SECTION SIX** The Executive Board shall be responsible for handling day-to-day expenses and authorizing approved expenditures.

**SECTION SEVEN** The Executive Board shall be responsible for prioritizing proposed projects, recommending policies and presenting budget proposals to the General Membership.

## **ARTICLE VI      POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**

The HHSCBC shall adhere to the following policies and procedures:

- A. The Organization shall be politically non-partisan
- B. The activities of the Organization shall be conducted on a strictly non-profit basis
- C. The Organization shall be subject to the policies an approval of the Principal of Harrison High School; the Cobb County Board of Education; the Georgia High School Association; the Georgia Public Schools Standards; and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Council on Accreditation and School Improvement.
- D. Upon the dissolution of the HHSCBC, the Executive Board shall dispose of its assets by transferring them to the cheerleading fund of Harrison High School financial records.
